

BEAUMONT YOUTH BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL CODE OF CONDUCT

The objective of Beaumont Youth Baseball/Softball shall be to implant firmly in the Children of the Community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, courage and respect for themselves, authority, and each other. To achieve this objective, Beaumont Youth Baseball/Softball WILL NOT TOLERATE actions of Managers, Coaches, Parents or Spectators that are detrimental to the league. Any person (this includes anyone associated with your child) found in violation of the following may lose the right to attend Beaumont Youth Baseball/Softball events for the season.

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:

1. Intoxication at any BYB Event
2. Parent/Fan Verbal abuse directed at Umpires, Players, Managers, Coaches and Spectators or League Officials.
3. Unsportsmanlike conduct, Grandstand managing, and/or Umpiring
4. Negative criticism of Umpires, Players, Managers, Coaches, Spectators or League Officials.
5. No Tobacco products in the Dugouts, on the playing Fields, or in the Bleacher areas.

SOCIAL MEDIA CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Do not use social media to be critical of teammates, coaches, officials, administrators, volunteers, or spectators.
2. When using social media, show the same respect and regard for people that you would show and are expected to show when playing, officiating, or attending a baseball game.
3. Do not post content that would harm BYBSB or damage BYBSB's reputation. Remember that even while you are on your own personal time, you are a representative of BYBSB, and people may interpret your online postings or social interactions as though they were official BYBSB statements.

VIOLATIONS TO BE HANDLED AS SUCH:

1. Verbal Warning to Manager, Coach, or Team Representative.
2. Ejection of offender & Manager, Coach or Team Representative.
3. Upon Ejection if you fail to leave, the Law Enforcement will be called.

Any violation of this policy shall be reviewed by the BYBSB Board, who will then determine if disciplinary action is warranted.
