Warm-Up Tournament Rules General Rules and Modifications

All Pony Baseball tournament rules and regulations apply with the following exceptions:

- 1. Slide to avoid contact rule in effect umpire's discretion
- 2. Time limits
  - a. Shetland 5 innings, no new inning after 1 ½ hours
  - b. Pinto 6 innings, no new inning after 1 ½ hours
  - c. Mustang 6 innings, no new inning after 1 ½ hours
  - d. Bronco 7 innings, no new inning after 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> hours
  - e. Pony 7 innings, no new inning after 1 ¾ hours
- 3. Semi final and championship games have no time limits.
- 4. Mercy rule 15 and 10 run rule in effect
  - a. Pinto and Mustang 3rd inning and 4<sup>th</sup> inning
  - b. Bronco and Pony 4th inning and 5<sup>th</sup> inning
- 5. You must bat your entire roster, 15 maximum.
- 6. May play with 8 players without taking an out for missing player.
- 7. Injured player who cannot bat will take an out in the line-up only the first time up.
- 8. No infield practice.
- 9. Clean-up dugouts and benches and bleacher areas after each game. Due to such tight schedule and field movement, please vacate dugout immediately.
- 10. Coin toss before game time will determine home team for pool play. Top seed for all others.
- 11. Pool play can end in a tie. Elimination, semi final, and championship games will follow the tie breaker rule. Last completed batter starts at 2<sup>nd</sup> base with no outs.
- 12. No metal cleats on the pitcher's mound.
